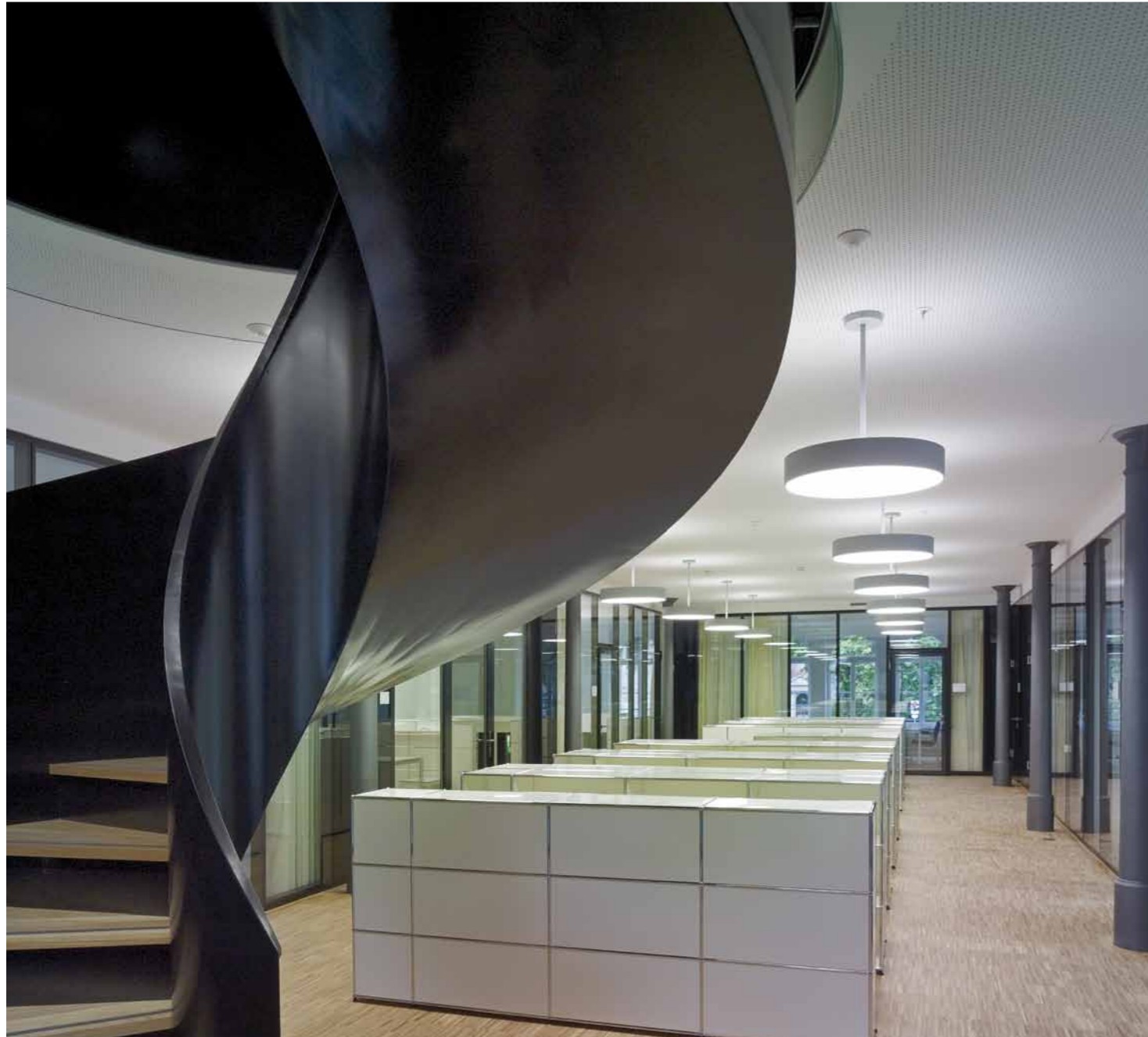

Armory Transformation Zug



This stone building in the old town of Zug dates from the end of the 19th century, and is listed as a historic monument. It was reduced to its basic structure, before extensive dry walling work took place on all four levels. It now contains the civil and high court of the Canton of Zug as well as the city library. The owner and architect chose plasterboard systems, as best suited to preserve the historic building's structure (compared to concrete or steel), to compensate for construction irregularities, whilst meeting the extraordinarily high demands on building physics.
